What principles does Jesus provide for judging others?

Identify some “specks” that you point out in others. Why is this so?

What “planks” are you blind to in your own life?

Why is it important to know God is a just judge?

How are justice and forgiveness related?

Share one take-away from the message or this study that you are going to apply moving forward.
